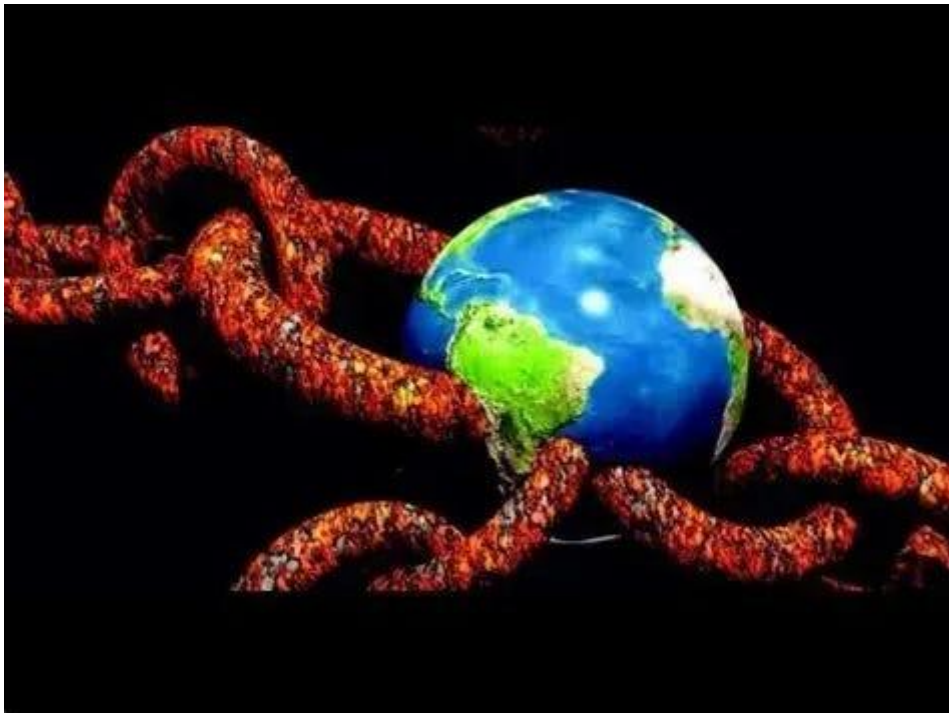


# The End of All Evil

## Freedom

Freedom = The value of the human being.

All evil desires to convince you that you have limited value. **All Truth is simple.** All evil creates overly complex ideas to obfuscate Truth. When overly complex ideas and fear are removed from our life we uncover a simple, beautiful, and plain Truth. This Truth is the nature of your self-worth. **The Truth is that you have value.** To understand Freedom you must first understand your value and to understand your value, you must understand Liberty.

**Everything that is evil seeks to destroy your value.** Authority is created by evil men to disguise your self-worth. Evil, which is Authority, seeks to challenge your value by denying you your ability to make choices based on your free will. Without the ability to make our own choices, there is no growth, learning, or development of understanding. In other words, **spiritual progress has been demolished.**

When spelled backward the word evil is live. **This is because evil is the very antithesis of all life. Evil seeks to destroy your ability to live.** All evil seeks to hide or destroy your self-worth, freedom, and liberty. Freedom, on the other hand, seeks to manifest your full potential and value. With freedom comes love, happiness, and peace. **Freedom is the exact opposite of evil.** The lesson is simple, *nothing on earth is more valuable than YOU.*

***Evil when spelled backward is Live. This is because Evil is the antithesis of our ability to Live. Life is freedom and freedom is life.***

## **Earth**

Understand that there is a grand and dark conspiracy at work on Earth and it has clouded the minds of humanity through many ages. **This conspiracy is Evil incarnate.** It is responsible for the deaths of millions and the slavery of nearly every being that has ever lived. **Above all else, understand this Principle. You have infinite worth.**

For us to understand how Evil has been able to control people, we must discern the [difference between a Principle and a Rule.](#)

Principles are based on Truth and generate freedom. Rules are based on lies and generate slavery.

A Principle will accurately describe reality and is a knowledge that helps us function in the world. **Every Truth you learn is a Principle.** Rules are artificial ideas created by evil men to restrict your thinking and understanding. **Rules impersonate Principle.** When people mistake Rules (the ideas of Authority) for Principles freedom is restricted and wisdom is diminished. This is why Rules were created.

Under a Rule, a person must neglect the usage of their mind, their speech, and their actions. **They must surrender their conscience, which is the internal knowledge of the difference between right and wrong.** To obey Authority is to believe you have less value than someone else. All Rules must be enforced because there is no Truth in them.

**Complexities in culture are called ideas.** Evil societies invent ideas to destroy freedom of thought. Some of these ideas are socialism, royalty, decency, and democracy. These ideas are created to confuse the minds of the victims of slavery.

Complex distortions were created by evil men to control you. Evil wants you to believe that you are incapable of understanding the world you live in. You are capable of understanding anything you desire. **Your intelligence is not limited.** Most of all, Evil's greatest fear is that you will come to know the *magnitude of your worth*. If you come to know your worth, Evil **will fail**.

1. **Simplicity states that intelligence recognizes Truth.** When a Truth is presented anyone is capable of understanding it. There is no Truth you can not learn.
2. **Obfuscation is the distortion of Principle.** Obfuscation is used by evil men to distort Principle and create false ideas to hide Truth. This is done to prevent you from learning and thus limit your freedom. Evil will often add a small lie to a Truth to make it believable while disguising the original nature of the Truth.

Who are you? You are a human being. This means that your life is not subject to any Will except your own. If you begin to shed the notion of our inferiority your search for knowledge will become easier.

**No one has the right to command the abilities of your intelligence.** You have the ability to dream for a reason. It is because it is in your *nature* to fulfill them. There is no limit to this nature. This means you require no license or permission to grow. **Anything you desire can be yours.**

**Faith is the courage to test ideas for Truth.** With faith, people can come to know whether ideas are true or false. When you test an idea and it is wrong it is a failure. **When we fail, we learn.** Your intelligence will then help you adjust your thinking to better understand the idea and the Truth it contains. The application of Principles in the world is based on Faith. **When human beings put Principles into action they will feel Power.** Always remember that as a human being the degree of freedom you require is *infinite*.

Never underestimate the cruelty of evil people. **Most people are not evil.** However, evil people do exist and they are extremely dangerous. They are called Authority. Life is liberty and anyone who tells you that you must yield your mind, your body, or your property to Authority *is doing evil*. Sacrifice without choice is not a sacrifice, it is slavery. Authority always places demands on people under threat of violence and never asks for permission.

**Authority wants you to believe that other people can manage your life better than you can.** Evil enslaves. Evil is found in things like taxes, violence, censure, and politics. In these things, there is no joy, none of which has any value to humanity.

There are different kinds of slavery. What most people consider to be “slavery” is just one form of it. If we are only in control of a portion of our lives are we considered free? Slavery is both found in the *partial* and *complete* destruction of freedom. The simple truth of that matter is that **if your freedom is limited in any way you are a slave.**

*That which destroys freedom is Evil.*

## **Authority is Evil**

**All human beings were born into this world as sovereign.** This means that your ability to feel, think, learn, and love is your liberty and yours alone. Evil seeks to destroy your liberty. The implementation of evil is called Authority. Authority seeks to limit your ability to feel, think, learn, and love. This is why authority is evil. **All evil wants you to obey its authority.** Authority uses two weapons to attack your liberty.

1. **Violence:** Theft, imprisonment, torture, rape, and death.
2. **Culture:** Rules and the control of speech. (aka. mind control)

When people are subject to violence they will obey authority. Violence is a threat to your physical body. People will subject themselves to Authority because its violence compels them to obey if they want to protect their freedom and their body. **The lie of tyranny is that for you to maintain your freedom you need to obey Authority.** You are offered either lifetime obedience or death. **Evil is the master of deceit.** Evil's object is not violence, *but obedience.*

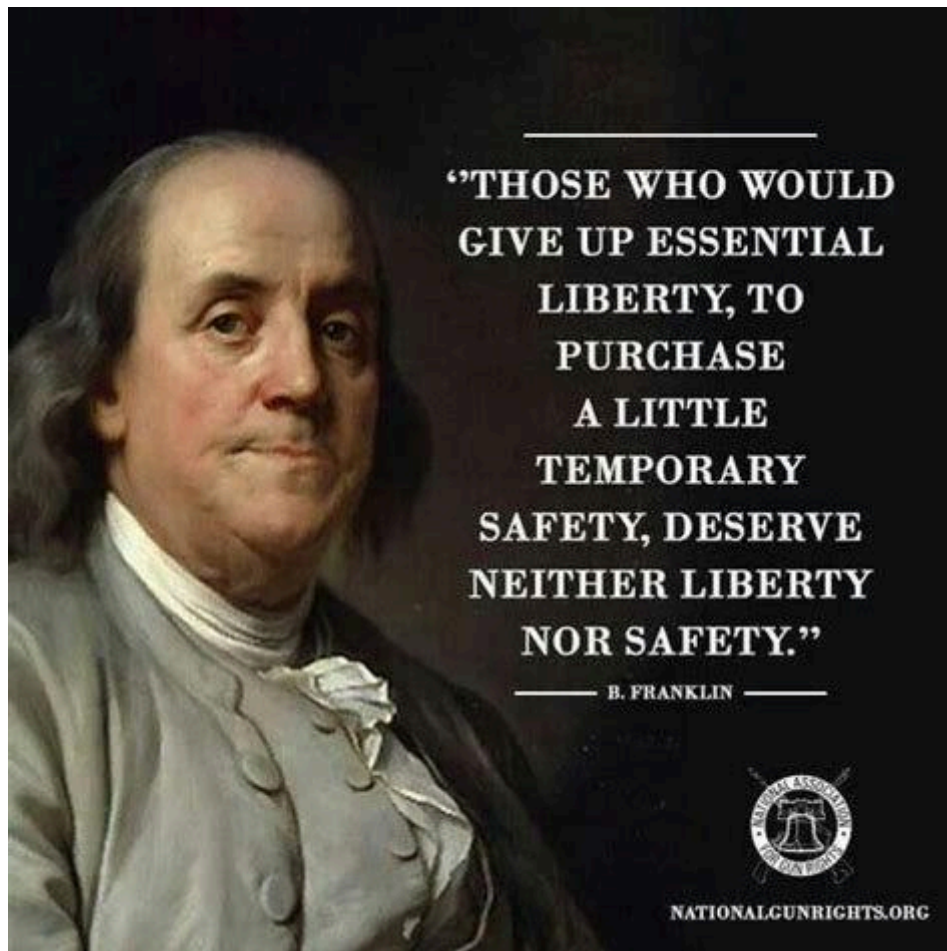
Culture offers differing views on morality (good and evil) and what is or is not taboo. Depending on the culture, evil will either be obvious or nearly impossible to see. **Whether or not people within a culture can recognize the oppression within it, oppression will always be oppression.** Most people believe that history's greatest villains misused their authority. The truth is, they followed the object of Authority perfectly. **To kill and enslave YOU.**

**Tyranny disguises itself as culture and Rule.** Tyranny seeks to control the minds of people by creating a culture of obedience. Before a tyranny can take place a war must ensue. **War is the implementation of violence.**

**War happens because a preexisting authority desires to implement a new power structure over its slaves.** Authority will seek to convince people that they can escape the violence of war if they obey. Authority conditions people to believe that they are offering protection from dangerous enemies who would seek to take their

liberty. Nothing could be more wrong. **The only evil that seeks to take your liberty is Authority and by far its most commonly used scapegoat is anarchy.**

For Authority to engineer a culture of obedience, it must create an enemy. **Authority does not care who the enemy is as long as the protection it offers is exchanged for obedience.** Whether or not someone wants to obey Authority they will because not doing so will result in violence. **All cultural enemies are an illusion.**



Safety is an illusion. To be alive means that certain death, at any moment, is always a reality.

**Evil will sell you the idea of security to get you to yield your liberty.** The demand for security is raised by those who seek power over you. This is how Authority creates artificial enemies. Remember, it isn't the enemy the tyrants are after, *they are after YOU*. Evil has designed this dialectic to restrict you and convince you that the real enemy isn't the one that rules over you, but some imaginary demon who would do you harm. **This is the lie of tyranny, tyranny requires your obedience for it to save you.**

Eventually, obedience becomes normality and even a way of life. It is natural to want to escape the violence of Authority. Government promises you that if you obey it, it will not obliterate your life. **This offer of obedience is sweetened with the illusion of enemies.** When people are offered in one hand to either obey or die and protection from an enemy in the other, most people will give in and relinquish their freedom to Authority.

Most people are taught by culture that rules are right. Instead of being told *what is right*, they are taught to obey rules. **Culture will try to convince you that rules are legitimate. This is the object of culture.** Culture wants you to believe that Truth is unknowable (solipsism) and that Truth is not objective. **Culture wants you to believe that peace can only be obtained when in obedience to Authority.**

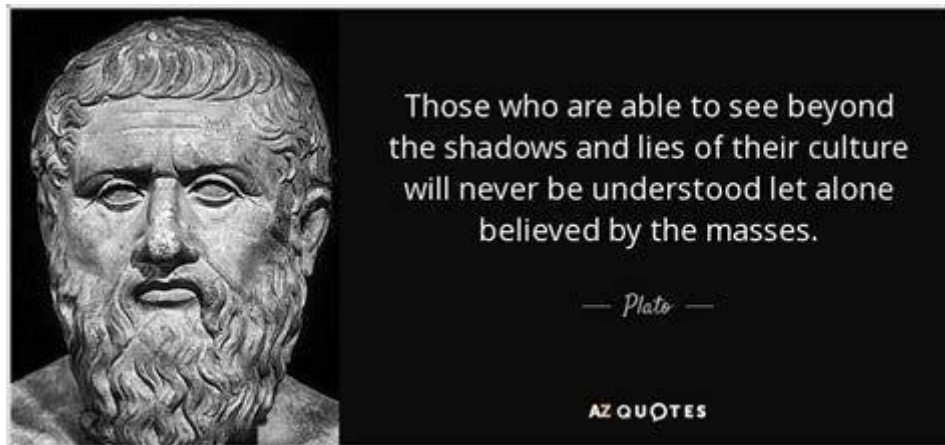
**All obedience is submission disguised as a virtue.**

Cultures desire to control speech to make sure that those who have bent on it will **never gain the courage to look back.** For Authority

to maintain obedience, it demands that its slaves enforce its will on everyone around them.

It teaches its followers to call those who do not obey its arbitrary demands weird, insane, immoral, and anti-social and to turn on those who fail to obey its precepts. They will be ostracized and demonized by those around them. Culture will call its evangelicals noble and upstanding and reward them for inflicting stigma upon those who refuse to obey.

Due to the loneliness that comes with being an outcast, many will give up their Will and return to the arbitrary and illusory world called culture. **This is designed to destroy freedom of speech.** Because those who see beyond the lies and illusion of their culture will be too afraid to speak it out of fear of societal stigma.



Telling the truth in a culture riddled with lies takes courage.

There are times when culture does not work on controlling the minds of the masses. In this case, Authority must revert to its second method of maintaining obedience. **Violence.** In every culture, there is a small

minority who refuses to obey its tenets and tell the Truth. **Because of this, the Authority must create law (rule) enforcement to maintain its control.**

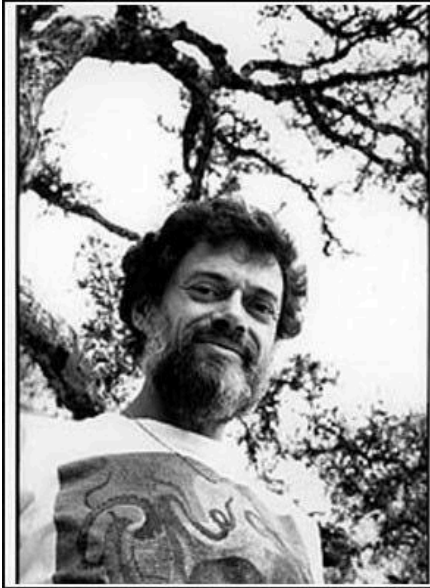
Although culture would have you believe that this violence is enforced to defend your liberty, in actuality it is done to preserve the control Authority has obtained. When culture breaks down, authorities must employ violence. **When people begin to awaken to their self-worth, demand more freedom, and realize culture is a lie, tyranny is doomed.** When the Authority begins to see that its culture of obedience is being dismantled the violence it employs will begin to increase as it tries desperately to hold its power over people.

*Always remember, when the violence of law (rule) enforcement becomes extremely brutal in culture liberty is on the rise!*

## **Culture is Evil**

Culture was created by the Authority to protect its power structure and to enforce its rules. Culture will try to convince you of its perverted concepts of morality and destroy your worth and freedom. **Morality is liberty. Anything that is immoral is evil.**

Prudence is the proper application of Principle. Culture is a collective cult. That's why it's called **CULTure**.

Culture is not your friend.

To be imprudent is to be foolish. If someone does something stupid it does not mean that they are incapable of intelligent thought. It means that they lack **wisdom in their actions**.

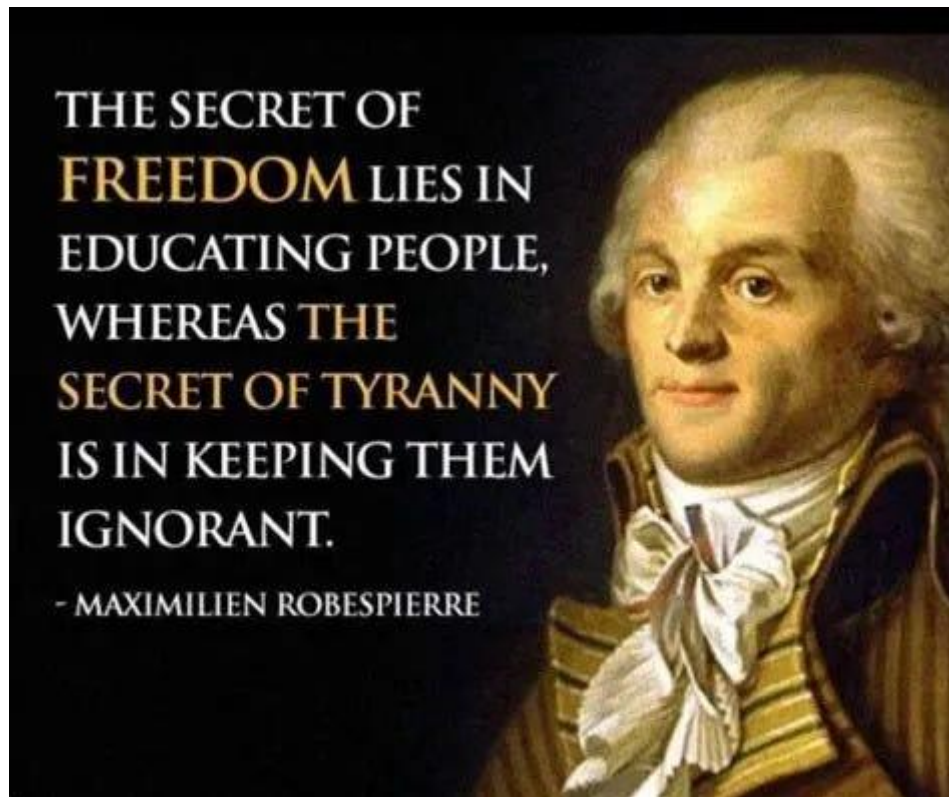
Prudence is not the same as morality. To kick a large stone is not immoral, it's foolish. Prudence is the application of Principles, and this is only possible with liberty. **Without liberty prudence is meaningless. Morality must be understood to be prudish.**

Culture wants you to believe that the rules of Authority are not bound by morality and that it can force you to be prudent. We learn by the processes of trial and error and need the freedom to make mistakes to gain wisdom and grow from immaturity into maturity. **Evil's objective is to prevent you from developing wisdom.** Culture pretends that evil is good and that good is evil. When a mistake is made, you learn prudence.

## **Prudence can never be enforced.**

Enforced prudence is called rules. You can't learn prudence unless you have the freedom to choose. Authority seeks to control speech through culture because **speech advances wisdom**. People can learn through experimentation, but they learn faster when they can communicate their thoughts through their speech.

Speech is *powerful*. Culture does not want the understanding of people to accelerate. **Authority relies on ignorance within its culture to maintain power**. When people become educated, the Authority loses its advantage over its population.

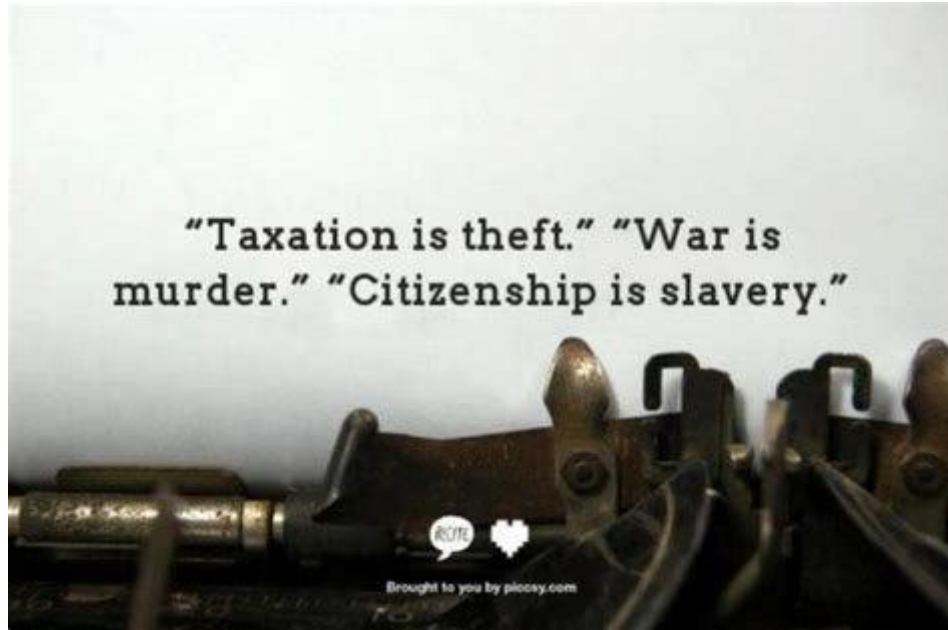


Knowledge is power and the prerequisite for freedom.

If people learned their worth and potential they would never submit to the artificial ideas placed over them by Authority. Culture is there to protect the powerful, and **the powerful are powerful because they have knowledge.** It's the culture's job to prevent free speech through the promotion of self-censorship.

Culture will label the questioning of Authority as immoral and to even *think* about defending yourself against its evil is wrong. It will teach that the positions held by it are respectable and even demand your respect. And if you openly state that you don't want Authority to interfere with your life you will be publicly scorned.

An example of this is taxes. The truth of the matter is that **if people weren't forced under the threat of imprisonment to pay taxes, no one would pay them.** No one ever pays a dollar more than what is demanded of them by their masters. Cultures teach people that extortion is good and that it is moral to steal someone's property without willful permission. **Taxation is done under the guise of helping the common good.**



When Authority is not questioned slavery is the result.

If you yield your mind to culture it will turn you into a tool for its evil deeds. This begins when you self-censor yourself out of fear of societal stigma. Culture manipulates speech by creating an air of politeness. **Politeness is called political correctness.** Political correctness is engineered slavery. It makes people believe that the enemy is impolite. **People like politeness because it hides them from having to face their demons.**

The coarseness of language threatens a culture because it removes illusion. **Words are not evil, they are just words.** Culture wants people to believe that some words are evil and others are not. Whenever you find an element of speech in a culture that is unacceptable, you will find its scapegoat. **If you are offended you have chosen anger and hurt for yourself.**

Culture also wants you to believe that there is danger in the discussion of ideas. New ideas will always challenge the accepted precepts of a

culture. **Ideas that are contrary to popular belief threaten a culture.** If people begin to see a new way of looking at the world, that culture will lose its control over people.

**Culture desires to *force speech* in a manner that is conducive to *cultural tastes*.**

Culture limits people's choices by creating arbitrary rules and **enforcing them through peer pressure.** When people don't stand up with their shoulders back because they have been conditioned into believing that they are not attractive enough, educated enough, or wealthy enough, culture is crushing their spirit and teaching them that they have limited worth. **You are worth it. You can only be convinced that you are not.**

**People who know their value are not easily controlled.**

A model citizen of culture models themselves perfectly to the ideals of the culture. Culture idolizes the perfect citizen. What this translates to is **unwavering obedience to Authority.** People who are easily molded to society are rewarded and those who do not meet the standards of servitude are humiliated and ridiculed. This breaking of the human spirit eventually *forces* conformity.

Culture wants you to believe that knowing your value is arrogance. There is a difference between arrogance and conceit. **Conceit is believing that you are more valuable than others. Arrogance is knowing your value.** People are taught that arrogance is conceit. No matter what culture would have you believe, *everyone* has equal value. Arrogantly know that you are capable of governing yourself and

that you can accomplish your dreams regardless of what anyone tries to tell you.

Enthusiasm for life is ridiculed by culture. Those who are excited about life and are full of wonder are in danger of knowing their worth. **Culture wants you to believe that you are average and that the achievement of your dreams is impossible.** Culture wants you to believe that success is limited in your life. **Dreams are hard to achieve because of culture.** Rules, control, and the consistent crushing of the human spirit by Authority limit your ability to achieve.

Culture often uses the word “only human” to imply the limited ability of the human being. **This phrase is a lie. Your intelligence is unlimited.** Cultures try to teach that intelligence is hereditary and that the powerful are more intelligent. Our intelligence is not limited by the construct of our brains. **People must believe in limitations to be obedient.**

Culture will also romanticize democidal warlords and historical atrocities. Culture wants you to ignore the nature of history. **The lesson of history is that humanity is always in a constant struggle against evil.** Genocide happens because the evangelicals of authority continue time and time again to “*just do their job*” of destroying the freedom of others.



“Just doing my job” will NEVER be an excuse for committing atrocities.

Patriotism is a code of honor created by nations in the same way chivalry was created for kings in the middle ages. Patriotism doesn't allow you to choose what nations you honor. Instead, you are demanded to give total allegiance to whatever nation you were born under by birth. **All cultures call disobedience treason. Treason is the disobedience of Authority.** The Truth is that nothing done under threat of violence is moral. **There is no such thing as treason.**

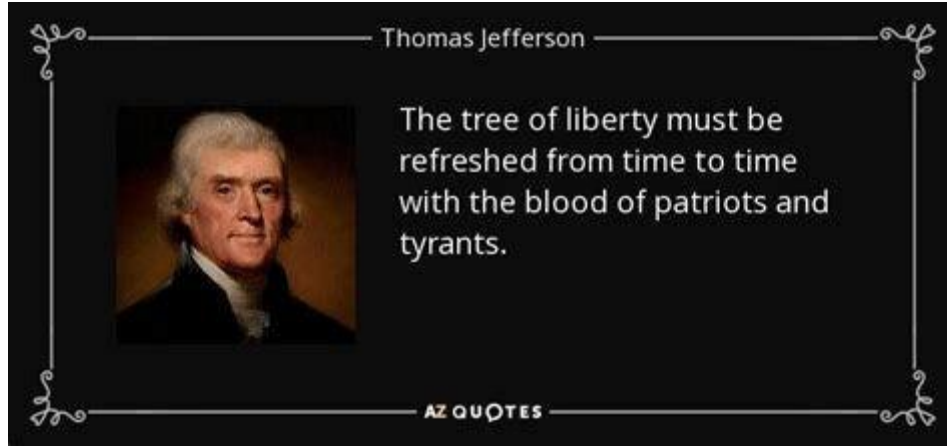
Culture teaches that morality is found in obedience. **Culture convinces people that slavery is moral.** Authority will use symbolism to create the unconscious illusion that its power is legitimate and it has rights that you do not. **Rule, rulers, and rule enforcers do not represent you, they represent evil.**

Culture creates collectivism and uses slogans such as “*we*” and “*our*” to crush individuality. **The destruction of the individual is collectivist and serves the purpose of evil.** Collectivism teaches that good things come from compulsion. It teaches that people can be forced to do things “for their own good.” **Choice enables life.**

***Insanity is not the inability to perceive reality, but the willful rejection of it.***

If you are willingly acting on an artificial view of reality you are insane. Cultural indoctrination is insanity. **Insanity is blind obedience.** Insane people believe that it’s right to impose power over other people. No human being who understands their worth would ever accept the idea that someone else ought to rule over them.

**Authority wants no possibility of rebellion.** It is the nature of evil to desire *absolute control* over others. **There is no compromising with evil people.** Evil will stop at nothing to destroy you, everyone you love, and your liberty, *totally*. Culture will teach you that you do not have the right to defend yourself and that self-defense is only the right of Authority. This is done to prevent rebellion. Rebellion is the only way to end tyranny because **the price of freedom is blood.**

## Tactics of Evil

***Anarchy is not tyranny, tyranny is anarchy.***

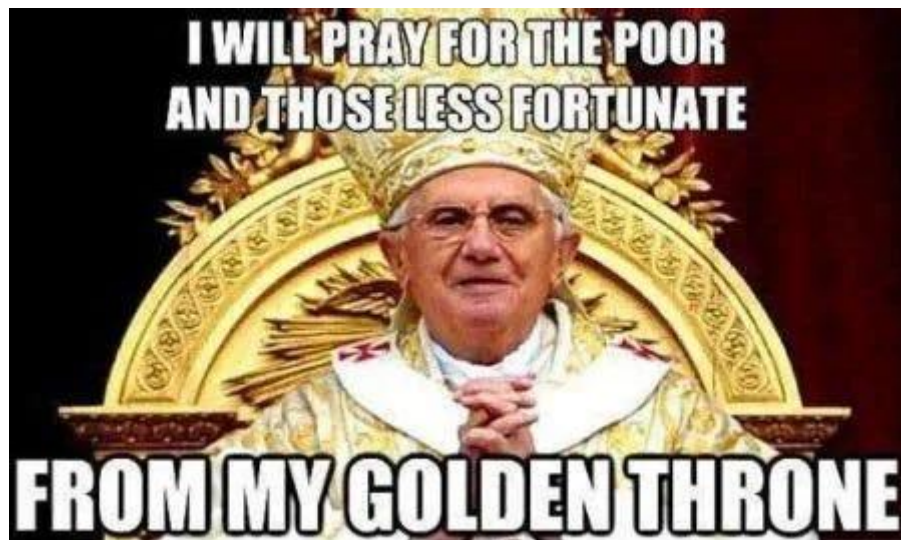
Culture must create enemies to maintain control. Some of these enemies are racism, terrorism, and communism. But by far the greatest enemy of culture **is anarchy**. In the absence of rule enforcement, you will not kill your neighbor because you are not evil. You have self-control and value. **Government is tyranny and it seeks to own you.**

From the beginning of time, there have been those who look at others and see them as a tool to be used for their evil machinations. **This mindset is primitive and lacking in wisdom.** Because of the unending brutality of evil its power over others rarely lasts. **All tyrants seek to free themselves at the expense and enslavement of people.**

As history progressed evil men devised more cunning ways of deceiving those around them into believing in the legitimacy of Authority (which is slavery). **They discovered that outright brutality only worked for so long** and that with a slight change in the usage of words, they could fool the common man into believing rulership and extortion were noble, just, moral, and even righteous.

**They created royalty.** Through cultural indoctrination and the use of titles, people began to believe that a specific family was greater than others and even compared them to Gods. **Nobility became the great father and mother,** the God family on Earth, who had the “divine right to rule.”

**To obey nobility was the greater form of respecting your father and mother.**

Extortion became just and few people fought back. Without culture, the reality of our world would become plain. **Their kings were nothing but thugs stealing at the point of a sword.** As new eras began culture began to disintegrate and freedom grew. The Magna Carta and the Declaration of Independence were created.

**The value of man was no longer a construct locked away in the mind, it was put to paper.**

The world learned that royalty was a lie. So evil invented another cultural trapping to replace it, **nations.** Under the guise of nationality, borders were drawn, and “our king” became “our country.” **The history of freedom shows that an increase in violence is not the rise of evil, but its death.** Nations create borders to keep their slaves within their locus of control.

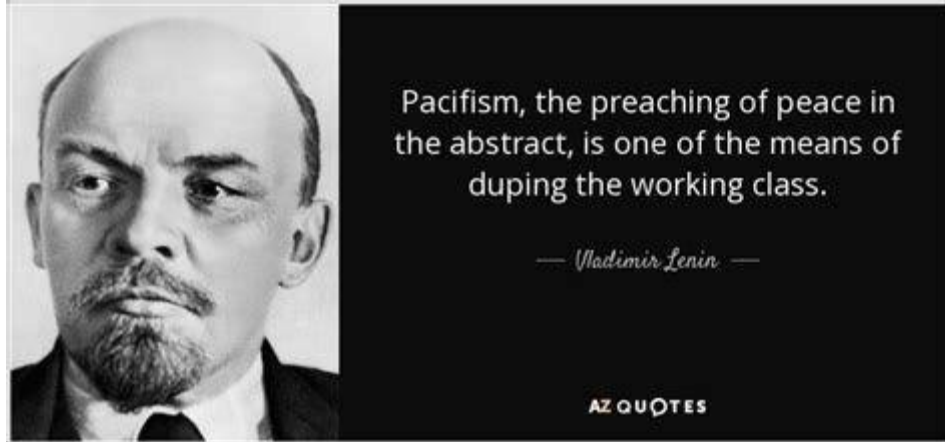
**Communism and socialism are the same.** They teach people that they are not able to produce enough to support their own lives and are given an enemy called the rich. Communism is the second most effective form of evil that has ever existed. Communism is the lie that the people are part owners of their production with the government. **Anyone who's read the history of communism knows it's inevitable result. Genocide.**

Socialism teaches people that they do not own their labor and distract people with ideas of duty and brotherhood. **Everything done under socialism and communism is forced and therefore immoral.** Ironically, under the pretense of ending poverty governments use violence to create more death and destruction than any famine or drought.

Dictators are the same thing as kings and royalty, **they all create a culture of nationalism.** It's only after that people learn the horrific atrocities committed by their great leaders. Another great mistake in trying to end tyranny is **pacifism. Knowingly allowing evil to happen and doing nothing about it doesn't stop evil from happening.** Anyone who believes this is insane.



Peace is active, not passive.

Culture conditions people to believe that morality can be enforced. People are capable of knowing the difference between right and wrong and can act on that knowledge accordingly. **Forcing anyone to do something, even if it is right, contradicts the very definition of morality.**

**Terrorism is the attempt to teach people that freedom is depravity and chaos and is to be feared.** As people become more fearful they turn to Authority for protection and liberty is sacrificed. Tyrants create terrorism because they are afraid of losing their control. In other words, **evil is afraid.**

Rights don't actually exist. There is no such thing as a right. **Right were created by men who wanted freedom but still believed that government was necessary.** Rights were divided up between government and people instead of being absolute in every human being.

Culture teaches that rule enforcement is necessary for our protection. This is an illusion. **Rule enforcement exists to defend the**

**mechanics of extortion.** Culture teaches that police are noble and courageous. Police are not courageous. Harming unarmed innocent people because they did not obey their evil master's dictates *is not courageous.*

## **Democracy is Evil**

Democracy is a construct of evil.

Democracy was created to **impersonate freedom** while maintaining the grip of control over people with rules. Democracy is designed to make slaves *think* they are masters while remaining slaves. Culture wants you to believe that democracy provides a voice for every person and that it is the best possible form of government.

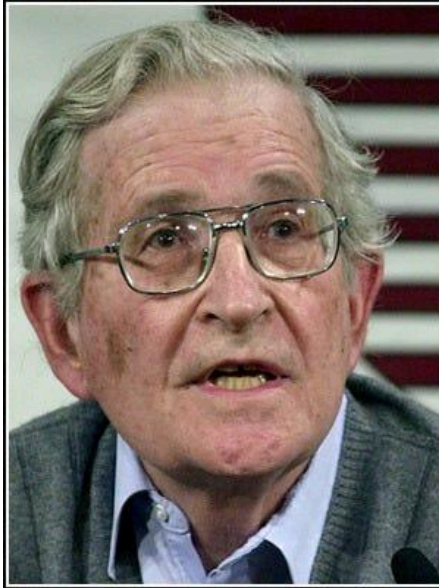
**Democracy allows *everyone* the opportunity to enslave you.**

**Because of propaganda democracy becomes rulership *by the stupid, of the stupid, for the stupid*.** Keep in mind the word stupid *does not mean people are incapable of intelligent thought. It means that they lack wisdom in their actions.*

**The destruction of *anyone's* freedom is wrong regardless of who says it.** Let's address a real-world example. At one time in the US, the majority believed that it was right to enslave African Americans because of their skin color. Did democracy moralize slavery? The answer is plain.

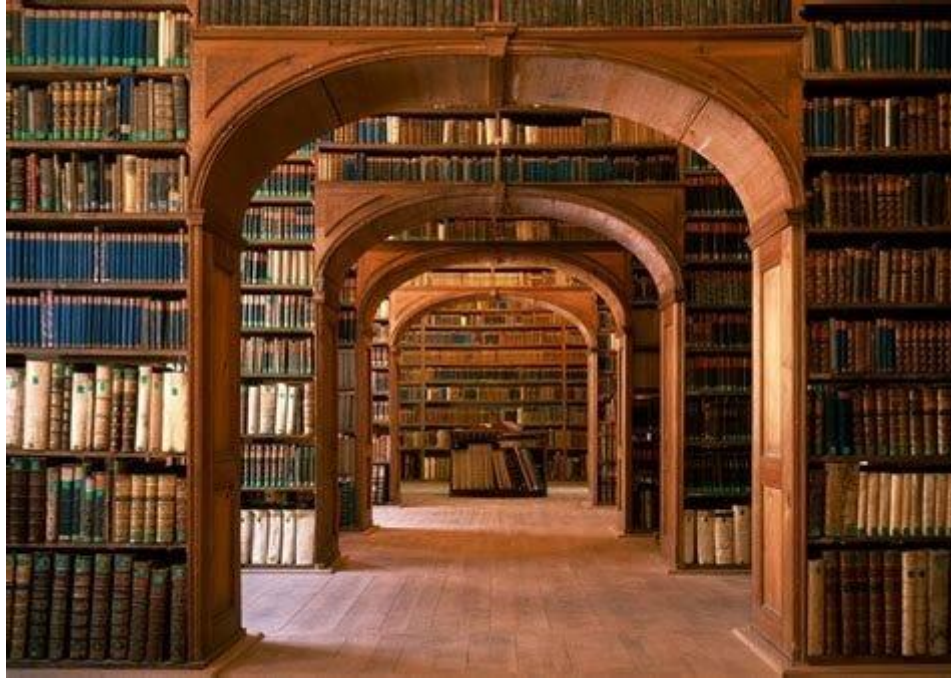
**There is no such thing as the minority or the majority.** These ideas were created to divide people. There are only people. Democracy will have you make a criminal of your neighbor and that it is proper to destroy liberty as long as the majority thinks it.

Democracies are always welfare states because it allows people to legitimize theft. **The strongest democracies will always have the highest taxes and the most regulation.** This is because government employees can influence the rules to benefit their positions. **The more regulations, the more pirating of property.**

The evil of democracy is greater than that of communism. It teaches that you are free to vote a *seemingly* better system and allows *everyone* to vote away your freedom. This makes it evil. What makes it **pure evil** is that *you also* now can take away *your* freedoms. **Everyone becomes a slave and everyone becomes the master of slaves. PURE EVIL.**

## **The Pattern of Liberty**

The word liberty comes from the Latin word *liber* which means to be free or not a slave. In ancient Rome the word *liber* also meant another word. **Book.** That's why places of learning are called **Libr-aries.** **This is because freedom is found in education. Education = Freedom.**

Gunpower allowed small bands and families to protect themselves from what previously was a monopoly on the ability to defend by governments and kings. The printing press allowed literacy to skyrocket, information became standardized, and nescience decreased dramatically. **All of these things accelerated liberty.**

What knowledge was previously only held in the hands of religious leaders became common knowledge with the printing of the Bible. **The printing press became the foundation of all technology.**

**The rebellion in America taught people that they were able to live without a king.** The experiment of America shocked the world and was enough to shatter the culture of royalty that has previously enslaved millions for thousands of years. **And the rise of the internet has destroyed cultural nescience once and for all.**

**In the age of information ignorance is a choice.**

Because of the internet information has become indestructible. Anyone, anywhere, at any time can learn anything they want. **Their ability to become knowledgeable is truly limitless.** When people are free to speak what they think, wisdom grows at an astonishing pace. For a culture to maintain its control, *it must keep people ignorant.*

**The end of intellectual property is the end of government.** Authority is under threat so its violence will grow. As people begin to learn about freedom, evil will begin to clamp down harder. Earth's era of war is over. This is evil's last attempt to maintain control and it will **give everything it has to prevent humanity from WAKING UP.**
